Safety precautions for transfer film adhesives containing dispersion

Attention: The following safety precautions must be observed when handling adhesives containing dispersion:

1. Storage and keeping

Store in a cool, dry and well-ventilated place.

Protect from frost and direct sunlight.

Close containers tightly after use to prevent drying out or clumping.

Do not store near food or drink.

2. Use

Only work in well-ventilated areas, especially when applying to large areas.

Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Wear suitable protective gloves and, if necessary, safety goggles.

Before use, ensure that the substrate is clean and dry.

3. Health protection

Skin contact: Wash affected areas thoroughly with soap and water.

Eye contact: Carefully rinse eyes with clean water. If irritation persists, consult a doctor.

Inhalation: If you feel unwell, leave the area and go into the fresh air.

Ingestion: Rinse out mouth but do not induce vomiting. Seek medical advice.

4. Environment

Dispose of product residues and containers in accordance with local regulations.

Do not allow dispersal into drains, sewers or ground.

Do not allow uncontrolled discharge of diluted residues.

5. Fire protection

Dispersion adhesive is normally non-flammable, but do not use near naked flames or hot surfaces.

Do not heat or incinerate containers.

6. Labelling


Observe the safety and hazard information on the packaging.

May contain sensitising or allergenic substances – observe warnings in accordance with the CLP Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008.

7. First aid

If you feel unwell, seek medical advice and have the safety data sheet to hand.

Ensure that persons in the surrounding area can inform themselves about basic first aid measures.
